

THE STRUCTURE OF SOCIAL SERVICES IN SPAIN AND EUROPE

INTRODUCTION

In the context of socially-focused public policies, the social services system in Spain and Europe constitutes a tool for action and social intervention to protect citizens and guarantee their social rights. This subject focuses on the Spanish social services system in the context of the European Welfare State of which it is a part. The object, concepts, action mechanisms and forms of provision of the Spanish social services system within the social and democratic rule-of-law State are examined in detail. For this purpose, legislation relating to social services and the general structure of the social services system is studied; specifically, its organization and main services and provisions at State, regional and local levels. Particular reference is made to knowledge of the social services network of the Community and City Council of Madrid. Similarly, legislation and forms of intervention by entities promoting social initiatives in the provision of social services, in their various forms, are examined: associations, foundations, non-governmental organizations, etc.

The methodology pursued in this subject will be a mix of theory and practice, with the purpose of offering students not only theoretical knowledge but also the ability to apply that knowledge in constantly changing contexts, having acquired practical abilities and democratic values.
